Parsha of the Week: Noah (Gen. 6:9-11:32)

Parsha Highlights: G-d despairs of the Creation of the universe, since the world has become violent, and resolves to flood and destroy it and start anew. Only one man is righteous in the entire world: Noah, whom G-d instructs to build an ark, taking upon it his wife and family, along with seven each of the kosher animals (for sacrificial offerings following the flood), and pairs of each of the non-kosher animals. Rain descends for 40 days and nights, after which the ark settles upon Mt. Ararat. Noah sends forth first a raven, and afterwards a dove, which does not return, having built a nest for propagating its young. After the waters recede, Noah plants a vineyard, distills wine from its grapes, and becomes drunk. Son Cham sees him naked, and reports to sons Shem and Yafet, who enter their father's tent backward so as not to view Noah's fallen state, and cover him with a blanket. Once sober, Noah curses Cham. Later, earth's inhabitants build the mighty Tower of Babel, but G-d confuses them by creating different languages. Finally, Avram picks up the Biblical epic.
