YOUR **DUES** WERE PAYABLE IN FULL BY AUGUST 15TH. ALL MEMBERS MUST HAVE RESPONDED TO THEIR JUNE BILLS IN ORDER TO BE ELIGIBLE FOR SEATS, UNLESS YOU HAVE MADE OTHER ARRANGEMENTS WITH THE OFFICE. SEATS MUST BE PAID FOR IN ADVANCE ONLY.

PERSONS WITHOUT TICKETS MUST HAVE I.D.'S.

BAGS/BACK PACKS MAY BE SUBJECT TO EXAMINATION.

ACCESS TO THE SANCTUARY WILL BE THROUGH STATE ST. UPPER ENTRANCE ONLY.

THE COURT ST. DOOR WILL REMAIN LOCKED.

LEAVE CHARITABLE DONATIONS IN STATE ST. LOBBY AREA.

THERE WILL BE NO STRUCTURED CHILDCARE FOR 9-12 YR. OLDS.

ANYONE NEEDING TO LEAVE THE SANCTUARY DURING SERVICES, MUST LEAVE THROUGH THE STATE STREET DOORS AND NOT THE TWO DOORS ADJACENT TO THE BIMAH. IT IS ASSUMED THAT PARENTS WILL BE SUPERVISING THEIR CHILDREN AT ALL TIMES.

FEE SCHEDULE

Membership entitles family members to two seats and single members to one seat at the High Holiday services. Additional seats are available for guests according to the fee schedule printed on the attached form. All fees are per holiday. THERE IS NO FEE FOR DEPENDENT CHILDREN UNDER 21 YEARS OLD. The fee is **PER HOLIDAY**: Rosh Hashana (both days) is one holiday, Kol Nidre & Yom Kippur the other.

1. DEPENDENT CHILDREN (age 21 and under) of a member
2. Non-resident GUEST of a member who is next of kin (e.g., father, mother, son, daughter, brother, sister living OUTSIDE the Seacoast area)
3. NON-RESIDENT (transient)

PARKING TIPS AND INFORMATION

Parking is very limited in the temple area. We recommend that you consider the **public** parking areas near the South Mill Pond and also at the High Hanover Parking Garage. These are your **best** options. Those who are capable of walking should be kind to those with limited mobility by parking at the surrounding lots rather than at the temple.

If you have parked near the temple (**ON COURT ST. and STATE ST. ONLY**), and get a parking ticket (FOR AN **EXPIRED** TICKET ONLY), you may turn them in to the temple office for a waiver. **PLEASE NOTE** that this waiver applies only to **EXPIRED** tickets, and only for a **LEGAL** parking space in this area. Applies only to Rosh Hashana Days 1 & 2, and Yom Kippur. Any exceptions to this means that **you** pay the ticket. Please note that this waiver does not apply to Sukkot, any tickets received on this holiday will be your responsibility. **Tickets MUST be turned in to the office by Friday, Oct. 15th or you will be responsible for the payment. PLEASE WRITE YOUR NAME ON THE TICKET ENVELOPE.**

Please do not block in anyone's car in any of the temple lots.

Age appropriate games and activities will include play dough, stickers, books and board games. Out of respect for these most holy days, cutting, pasting, coloring, writing and music will not be part of the activities. A light snack will be provided to all children enrolled in the childcare program.

Children must be signed in and out by parents. This is for your child's safety and security.
