In April we continued learning about writing letters, as well as the importance of keeping in touch with friends and family.

On a sunny spring day, the children walked to the post office. They bought stamps, added them to their addressed envelopes, and mailed letters to themselves here at the ELC and to their homes. They liked getting mail, so if anyone wants to write us a letter, we would be thrilled to answer you back!



Learning about Pesach, we used model Seder plates and sat with the children to talk about why Seder night is different from any other night. We talked about the items on the Seder plate and what they represent. We asked the Four Questions and together learned the answers and their importance in honoring what all the slaves of Egypt had to endure until Moses came to lead them to the promised land. Using a Preschool Haggadah, the class enjoyed showing their parents what they had learned.
